The Position

California State University, Dominguez Hills, invites applications for one full-time tenure track position at the rank of Assistant Professor of Economics and International Business in the Department of Accounting, Finance & Economics, College of Business Administration and Public Policy. Teaching needs include undergraduate economics classes, international business courses, and graduate finance courses. The appointment will be effective fall 2018 semester. Appointment and start date might change and are subject to the availability of funds.

Teaching duties may consist of day or evening classes. Teaching responsibilities might include both undergraduate and graduate courses, and might include online courses. Additional responsibilities include research and service consistent with the mission of the University and the College of Business Administration and Public Policy. Published research in support of the mission is expected and required for tenure and promotion

The Ideal Candidate

The ideal candidate must have a Ph.D. degree in Economics or International Business and be qualified as Scholarly Academic (SA) in teaching area based on 2013 AACSB standards, by time of employment. A track record and a commitment to teaching excellence and publications in quality journals are required.

- A track record of teaching excellence and publication in quality journals is preferred.
