Special Issue of *Economic Inquiry*
“Social Dilemmas”

In conjunction with the Seventh Biennial Conference on Social Dilemmas hosted by the Cleve E. Willis Lab at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, *Economic Inquiry* will be publishing a Special Issue on the topic of Social Dilemmas. The Special Issue aims to highlight recent advances in and state-of-the-art research on the topic of social dilemmas. While papers that have been presented at one of the Social Dilemmas conferences will receive special consideration, we also invite authors to submit suitable papers that have not appeared in one of these conferences. We seek to highlight research covering a wide range of methodologies focusing on providing innovative ways to better solve or understand social dilemmas of any form.

Co-Editor of *Economic Inquiry*, Tim Salmon, will oversee the special issue along with a guest editorial committee of current and past organizers of these conferences consisting of John Ledyard, **Charlie Plott**, **Louis Putterman**, and Angela de Oliveira.

All submissions will undergo *Economic Inquiry*'s standard editorial and refereeing process and must meet the journal's high bar of quality to be included in the special issue. To be considered for the special issue, papers should be received by ***December 15, 2017***.
